


Dice Box Advertising Hoardings

A set of fold-up advertisements designed to fit into Chessex-style dice cubes. I used 170gsm matte paper from Jessops, you'll have to see what works best for you.


Instructions


- 1. Print out the last page of this PDF. Make sure to print at 100% and do **NOT** use 'fit to page' settings. Although it's an A4 page there should be enough space at the ends for US Letter paper to work as well.
- 2. Cut out the four box nets along the outer outlines. No further cutting should be required.
- 3. Fold and crease the four remaining lines (square top to sides, between the four sides).





4. Place the folded ads inside the dice cube, making sure that the inner surfaces of the dice cube are clean first.





- 5. As dice cubes vary slightly in size between batches and manufacturers you might need to resize the print slightly if the boxes are too large or small.
- 6. If the ads are too high, you might need to remove the grey border along the bottom. With the dice boxes I'm using these borders stop the card from sliding down inside the cubes during play. If the bottoms of the cubes look like the ones below, they need to have the dip showing, like the one of the left.
